### Spellings

Your child is given a list of spellings to learn every week and you will find a copy of the list of words in their red spelling book. Some of the words follow a spelling rule or pattern whilst others are taken from the statutory year 1 and 2 lists. Your child's weekly words are also put onto the SpellingShed website where they can practise them within a range of games!

### Reading

We recommend that your child is reading every day for a minimum of 10 minutes with an adult. Each child has a levelled book and a phonics book which will be changed regularly in school. Alongside this, children have a reading record which we ask adults to use to record what your child has read. Adults can support their children's reading by asking questions, such as, how did the character feel? What do you think will happen next? Why? Can you retell me the story? Do you like this book / author?

**We recommend that children practise their maths, spellings and reading, in regular, short sessions every day. Your child's class teacher will monitor the amount of time, games and quizzes that your child completes and they will be rewarded with House Points to reflect how they have engaged with each aspect of the homework we have set for them.**

### Creative Task

This half term we are learning about explorers Ernest Shackleton and Christopher Columbus! We would like you to become an explorer! Think about what country or continent you would like to explore when you grow up. Research and create a booklet, poster or even a model of your place to show your teacher. It could include pictures or maps, the language, flag (if it is a country) and details of what animals, plants and habitats can be found there. You could also add information about what an explorer would need to pack for a good trip!
