For pupils eligible for Pupil Premium funding, half of this will be subsidised by the school and the cost will therefore be **£2.40**. Please pay for the trip online via ScoPay or return all monies in a clearly marked envelope with your child's name and class by **Friday 28<sup>th</sup> March**. Whilst no child will be excluded from this visit, should there be insufficient contributions received, we may need to cancel the trip. If you have any worries or questions about the payment, please let us know.

It is **ESSENTIAL** that children **wear a coat and appropriate footwear** for the trip. The children will be outside for the whole day. We shall be walking on possibly wet grass and uneven ground. Get those walking shoes on kids ☺
