This term we would like your child to complete weekly homework for spellings, maths and reading. We also have three other activities for you to complete if you would like to have a go at these.

Maths - 10 minutes x 5 times per week

Each week, we would like your child to login to Numbots and MathShed to practise their number facts. Year 2 can also log in to TTRS so they can practise their times tables.

Spellings - 10 minutes x 5 times per week

Your child will be given their list of spellings for the whole half term at the start of each new half term. These will be stuck in their pink homework book. Some of the words follow a spelling rule or pattern whilst others are taken from the statutory year 1 and 2 lists. Your child's weekly words are also put onto the Spelling Shed website where they can practise them within a range of games or they can record their work in their pink spelling book. **Please bring pink homework books in every Monday for any homework from that week to be checked.**

Reading – 10 minutes, 5 times per week

We ask that your child reads for 10 minutes, 5 times per week with an adult. Each child has a levelled book which will be changed regularly in school. Alongside this, children have a reading record which we ask adults to use to record what your child has read. Adults can support their children's reading by asking questions, such as, how did the character feel? What do you think will happen next? Why? Can you retell me the story? Do you like this book / author? If your child does not have a reading record, please let your child's teacher know. **Reading records should be bought in everyday in their packs by children and they will be checked and stamped by an adult on Monday.**

Creative Task

In art this half term, we are going to be looking at Van Gogh's 'Starry Night' painting. We would like your child to be inspired by the artist and for them to recreate their own version of the painting. We would like to encourage them to use natural resources such as stones, twigs, leaves etc if possible.

With members of your family or friends, you could write some activities or places you might want to visit this year and put them in a jar ready to be picked.
